Before you graduate please be sure to check on the following:

RELEASE OF RECORDS . . . Please make sure that you have a release of records on file in the Guidance Office. Most of you filled out this form in September (*the pink form*), however a few of you did not. This form gives us legal permission to send your transcripts. Even if you are not planning on attending college immediately after graduation this form is important to have on file. Many employers will request a copy of your transcript and this will enable us to provide them with a copy. If you have any doubts if you filled the form out stop in the Guidance Office and check.

FINAL TRANSCRIPTS . . . Please be aware that the Guidance Office **DOES NOT** automatically send out final transcripts to colleges. As you make your decision on your final college choice please notify the Guidance Office of your choice before you graduate. (The purple final transcript form is available in the Guidance Office)

NCAA CLEARINGHOUSE . . . If you are even remotely considering playing sports in college please make sure that you register with the NCAA Clearinghouse. This is now an on-line registration and the website is <https://web1.ncaa.org/eligibilitycenter/common/index.html>. Please make sure that you print your transcript request forms (copy 1 and copy 2) and bring them to the guidance office.
